Oshkosh Public Library Highlights June 2017

- 1. The library's Summer Reading Program is off to a strong start, with our Drop In & Read kickoff event drawing more than 500 people. At the event 370 kids and teens signed up for summer reading and read for 20 minutes to earn a pool pass to Pollock Community Waterpark.
 - So far 1,334 children and 217 teens have signed up for the Summer Reading Program. Of special note is the large sign-up from the Boys and Girls Club this year. In past years, only avid readers signed up, but the club has implemented a regular reading schedule this summer, so all 264 of their summer program participants are registered. Library staff will check in with the club to help keep kids motivated and will supply book collections to give the kids more reading variety.
- Outreach to Oshkosh middle and high schools has resulted in increased participation in teen
 events already this summer. There was a significant increase in the number of teens who
 attended Drop In & Read and the first summer meeting of the Teen Book Club drew 16 kids, 10
 of whom were new to the book club.
- 3. OPL is piloting a new outreach program, Time Capsule, at Gabriel's Villa retirement community. Using local history information as a starting point, a volunteer leads informal conversations that encourage residents to reminisce and share stories from their past. The activity director at Gabriel's Villa said that this type of program is a good fit for their residents and keeps them engaged in a positive way.
- 4. The library has been promoting our used book store by offering coupons via community events. Coupons were handed out to participants who stopped at the library for the BikeOsh event on May 20. As a result of connections made during that event, the Oshkosh Police Department is also handing out book store coupons to kids as part of their summer rewards program.
- 5. Twenty four Wisconsin photographers exhibited their bird photography at the library during Bird Fest Under the Dome on May 6. More than 360 people came to the exhibit during Gallery Walk. The library partnered with the Oshkosh Photography Group for the event, which was part of the 7th annual Oshkosh Bird Fest.
- 6. Family programs at the Oshkosh Masonic Center have been well-attended so far this summer. More than 259 people attended two shows by Michelle's Magical Poodles on June 13 and 180 people attended two performances of the Miller & Mike comedy show on June 20. Presenting shows at the Masonic Center allows for larger audiences and eliminates the need to require tickets.
