

Renewing

Renewing a book doesn't extend your lending period. Instead, it lets you borrow the book again immediately after your current checkout expires (if there are no existing holds) or it places you on the wait list to borrow the book again as soon as possible (if there are existing holds).

Tap the Request Again button located under the book cover on your Loans page.

Title that you've requested again will appear on your Holds page and will be automatically checked out to you as soon as they're available again.

Once you receive an email indicating the title is available, you need to go to your Loans page to download again.

How many books can I check out?

You can check out 10 items.

How many holds can I have?

You can have 10 holds.

How long is the lending period?


The default for ebooks and audiobooks is 7 days, but you may choose up to 21 days for ebooks and 14 for audiobooks. When borrowing a book, you can change the lending period for just that title.

What happens when that time is up?

When the lending period ends, the ebook or audiobook will expire. You don't have to return it, but you can by tapping and holding the cover in your app bookshelf.

How can I change my default settings?

Tap on the book icon on the top of the page which will take you to your Loans page. Tap Settings. You can also set your content preferences under Settings.

Getting Started

Install the OverDrive app from your device's app store and then open the app. Choose the option of signing up with your library card.

Choose Oshkosh Public Library or Winnefox Library system from drop down list.

Enter your library card number and pin (last 4 digits of your phone).

Adding a Library

Swipe the screen to open the Home menu or tap the icon in the top left corner.

Tap Add a Library.

Search your zip code.

Tap Oshkosh Public Library.

Tap the star to save Wis. Public Library Consortium.

Logging In

In the app, tap the icon in the top-left corner to open the Home menu and tap Wis. Public Library Consortium.

Sign in using your library card number and pin (last four digits of your phone).

Searching for Books

If you know what you would like to search for, tap the magnifying glass and enter your search term(s).

To browse titles, you can use the Subjects menu near the top of the website to view all subjects in your library's digital collection.

Or, use the Collections menu to see collections of newly added titles, popular titles, or spotlight collections.

Filter by choosing format, Available or date added.

Use Advanced Search to limit your search.

When you find a book, tap Borrow. Banner on top of book cover will inform you if it's Available, Wait List, or Coming Soon.

Go to your Loans (book icon at top of page).

Tap Add to App. If the eBook comes in multiple downloadable formats, tap Choose a format, then select EPUB eBook to add it to the OverDrive app.

If you choose Kindle, you will go to Amazon. Tap Get Library Book, sign into your Amazon account, tap Deliver To (choose your device).

Tap the book to start reading.

Returning and Deleting Books


ePub books and audiobooks can be returned early on the app.

From the app Bookshelf, tap and hold down on the cover.

Tap on Return to return book early.

If book has expired, then tap Delete to remove from Bookshelf.

For Kindle books, sign into your Amazon account and go to Manage Your Content and Devices. Tap on Actions. Return or Delete your book.



Tap for Details on the title: description, reviews, number of holds.

Tap to add to your Wish List.



Tap to get to Loans page.

Holds

Tap the Place a Hold button under a title. Enter your email address.

When the title is available, it will be automatically checked out to you. You'll receive an email notification letting you know that it's waiting for you on your Loans page.

You can also suspend and edit your holds.
