Unleash your creativity this summer with *It Came from Oshkosh: A Sci-Fi Short Film Project*. Make a creature feature, schlocky short – your very own cheesy sci-fi flick that’s destined to become a cult classic! The library has resources, programs and tech know-how to inspire and support you in your filmmaking journey.

#### Rules for submission

- This project is open to participants of all ages.
- Videos should be no longer than three minutes.
- Recommended formats for videos include MP4, AVI, MOV and WMV.
- Videos must be appropriate for all ages – in other words, Rated G!
- Any style film is acceptable: live action, animation, music video, stop motion animation, etc.
- Films must include an opening title card and closing credits (including director’s name, actors and other participants you would like to recognize).
- Video must be original, not copied from another source (re-creations or parodies are acceptable); it must not violate the rights of any other person/entity.
- You may use only original or royalty-free music in your video. Do not use commercial music clips from films, television, music videos, etc.
- Films may be submitted starting Mon., Aug. 5. Deadline to submit is noon on Fri., Aug. 23, 2019.

#### Submitting your video

- Submit your video using this online form or download the form here and submit it with your video on a flash drive to the library’s First Floor Service Desk.
- You must submit a signed release form to [toland@oshkoshpubliclibrary.org](mailto:toland@oshkoshpubliclibrary.org) or bring a signed copy to the First Floor Service Desk with your flash drive and entry form.
- By submitting your video, you are giving the library the right to use it for promotional purposes.
- Oshkosh Public Library may not be able to return the submitted storage device.
- Videos submitted for this project may be selected for the It Came from Oshkosh Sci-Fi Film Festival, held at the Time Community Theater on Sat., Aug. 31 at 2 p.m. If your video is chosen, you will be notified via email.
